Human Needs & Economic Opportunity

Poverty Law Journal First of Its Kind in the Nation

Students at Georgetown University Law Center have launched the nation's first law journal to focus on understanding and addressing the problem of poverty, the *Georgetown Journal on Fighting Poverty*. The premiere issue was published in January 1994.

"We started this journal because we wanted to use our legal education to make an impact on the pressing social problem of poverty," said Shana DeSouza, a third-year who serves as co-editor-in chief with fellow third-year Leonard Adler. DeSouza and Adler have worked with over 30 law students during the past two years to establish the journal. Georgetown faculty member Peter Edelman, a recipient of the 1993 NAPIL Outstanding Public Interest Advocate Award, served as the journal's faculty adviser prior to accepting his current position as counselor to the Secretary of the Department of Health and Human Services.

The first issue features articles written by Barbara Sard, director of Greater Boston Legal Services' Homelessness Unit, and Martha Davis, a staff attorney at the NOW Legal Defense and Education Fund. The issue also contains a memorial to former Supreme Court Justice Thurgood Marshall and a symposium titled "Dear Mr. President: Fighting Poverty in a New Administration." The memorial was written by Georgetown professors Susan Low Bloch, Vicki Jackson, Michael Seidman and Mark Tushnet, who all served as clerks to the late justice.

The journal is unique to the law journal community in that it takes a holistic approach to examining poverty, through a focus on law, policy, practice, and voices of poor people. Thus, readers will find articles from legal scholars as well as from legal practitioners working on the front lines of the fight against poverty. To incorporate the perspectives of poor people, the journal publishes essays and poetry

written by poor people and interviews conducted by staff members. In addition, the journal uses an innovative 8 1/2 X 11 format, selected to make the journal accessible to a diverse readership.

The journal's second issue will be released in April. Subscriptions are \$25/year, and low-income individuals can request a reduced rate. Call (202) 662-9468 for subscription information or (202) 662-9425 for information about submitting work for the journal.

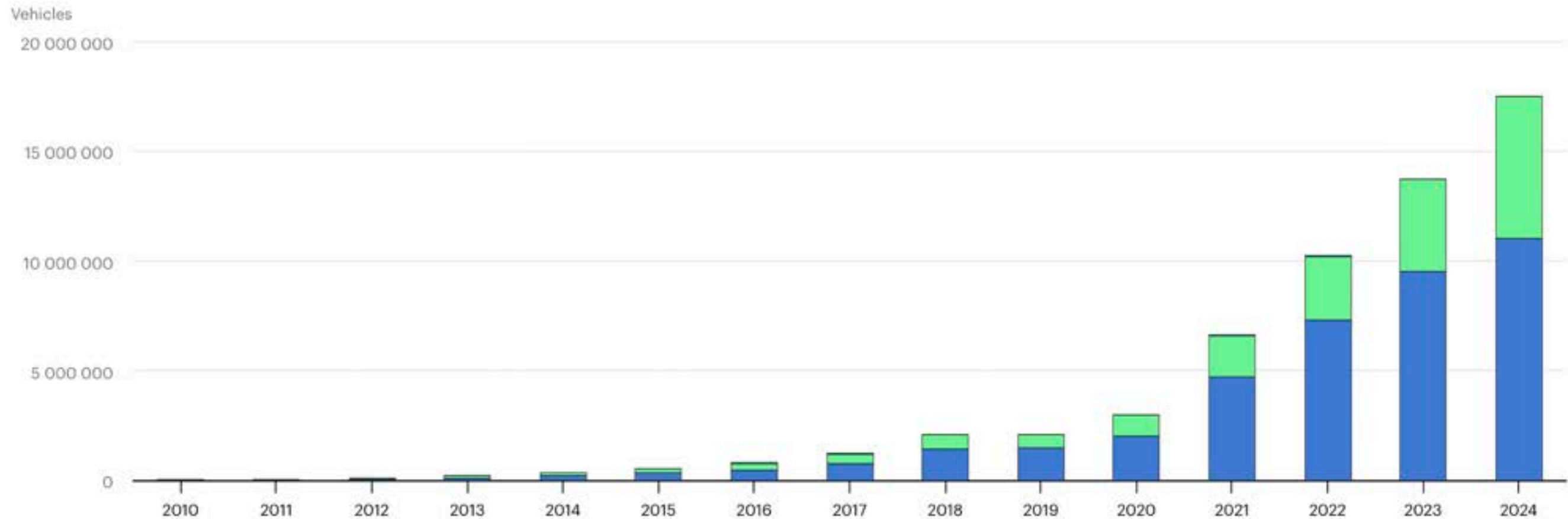

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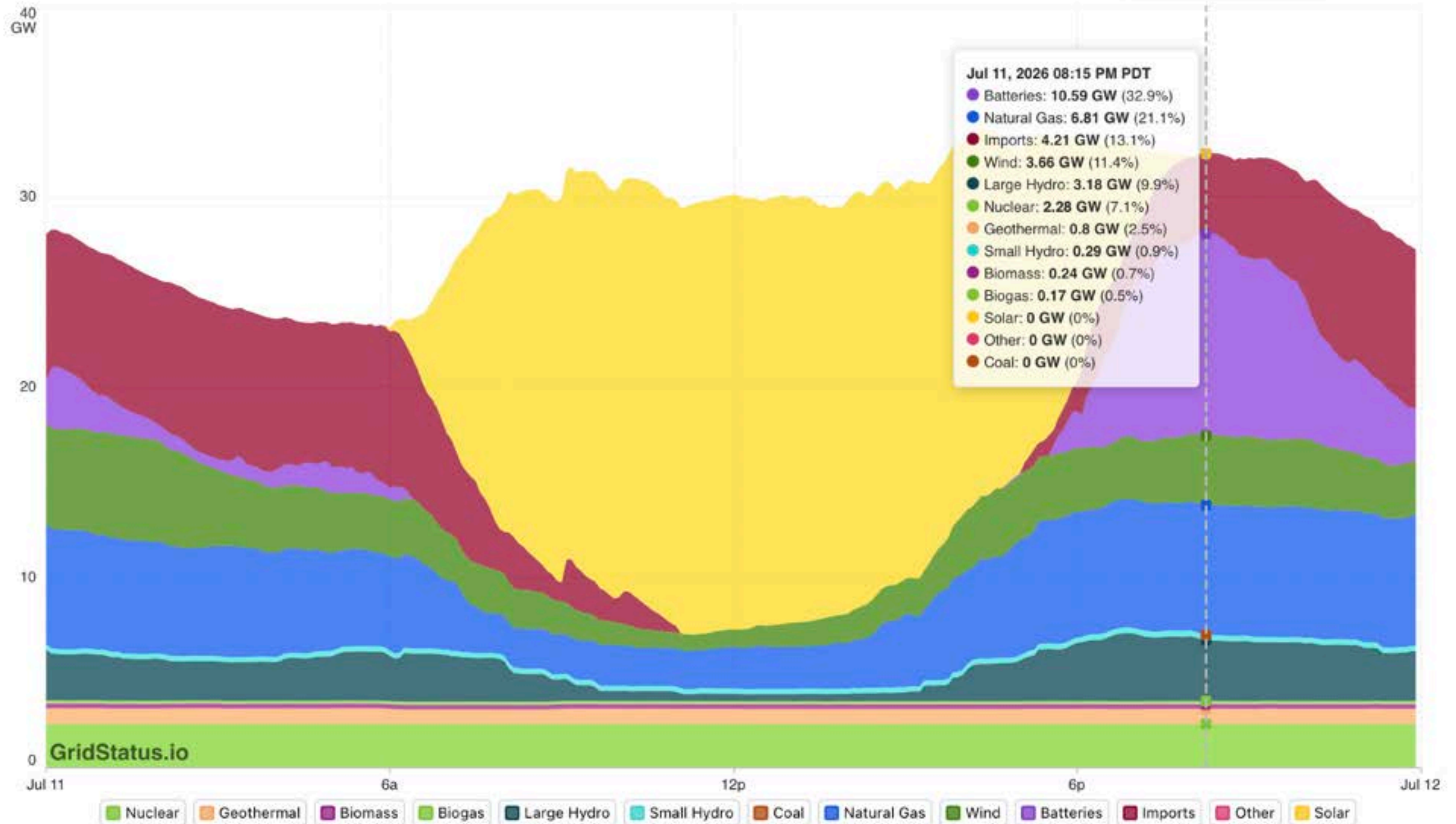

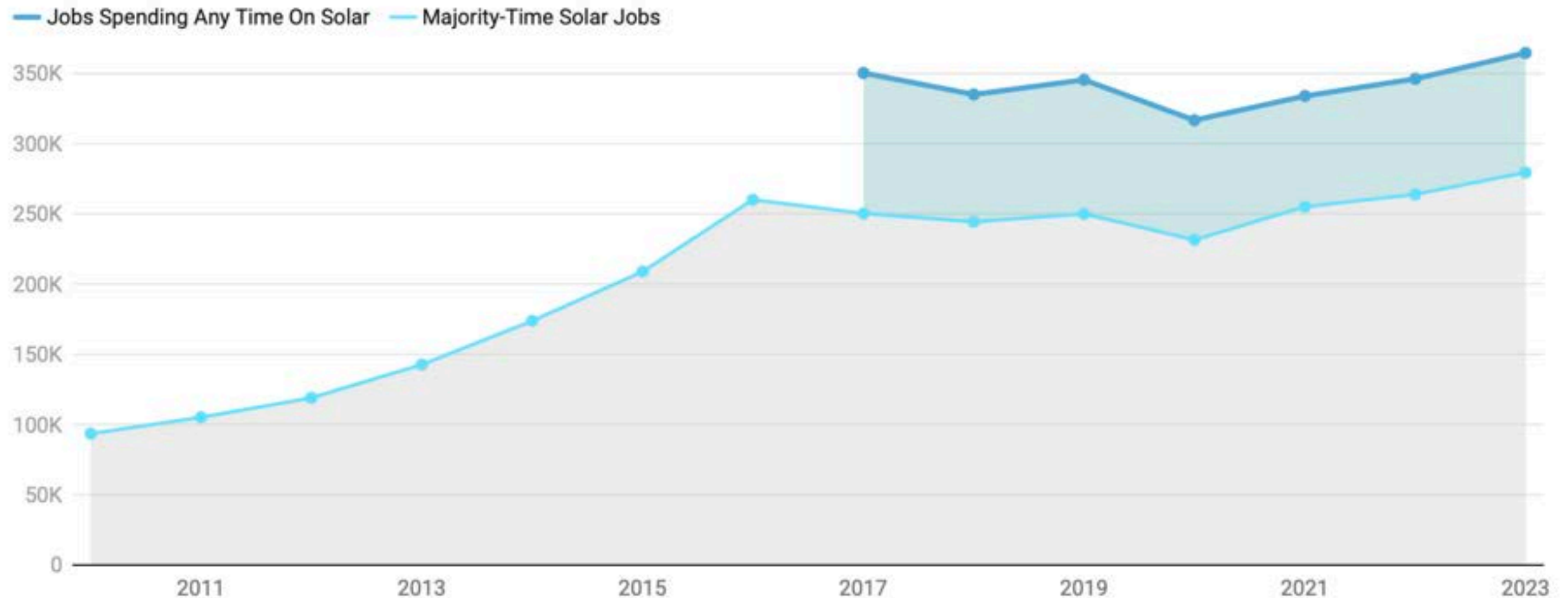

Massachusetts Clean Energy Center's 2024 Industry Report finds 100% growth since 2010 and identifies need for 28,000 additional workers by 2030

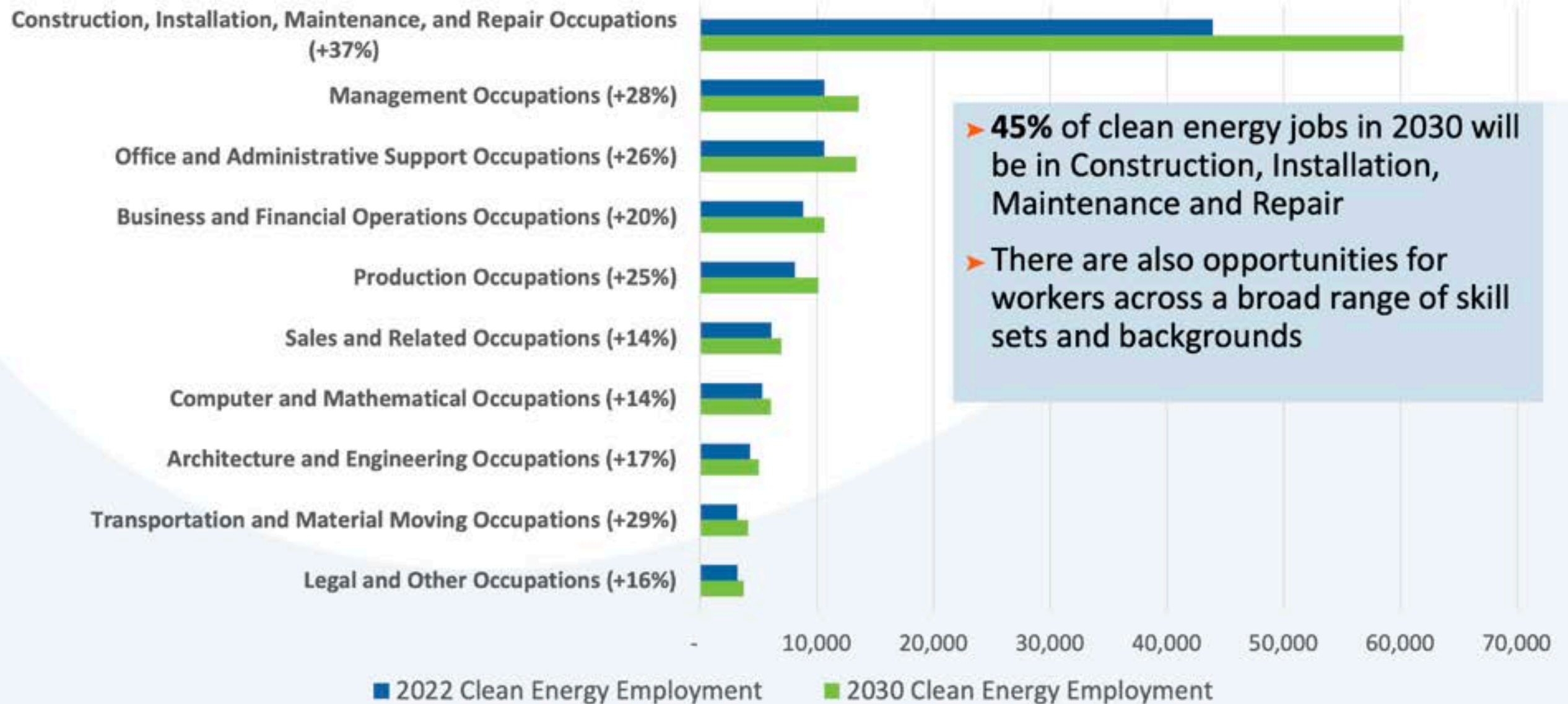
BOSTON – The [Massachusetts Clean Energy Center](#) (MassCEC) released its [2024 Massachusetts Clean Energy Industry Report](#) today, highlighting that the clean energy industry is home to over 115,291 direct clean energy workers, having grown 100 percent since 2010. The industry contributed more than \$15.9 billion to the Gross State Product (GSP) in 2023, a 74 percent increase since 2012. It also shows that 7,512 clean energy businesses exist across the state. Regarding direct jobs, the clean energy industry has a similar number as the College & University or Scientific Research industries, yet exceeds both industries' economic contribution in indirect and induced jobs and state GSP.

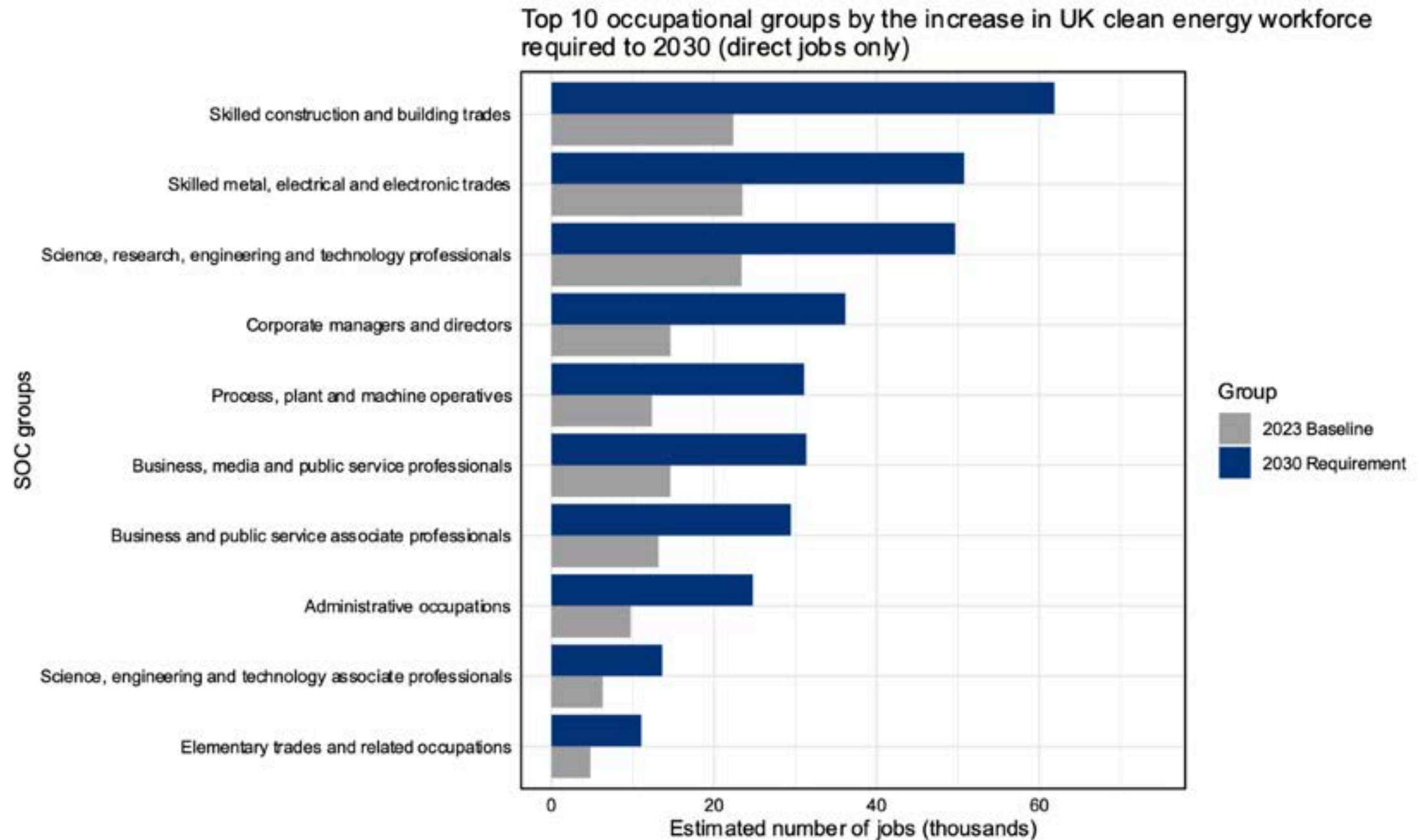

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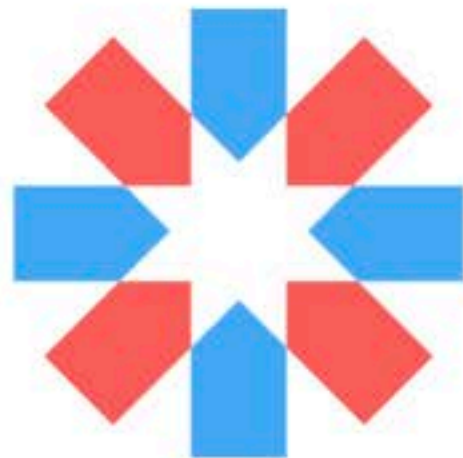

The Hidden Job Market

- This could be due to staff capacity, financial considerations, etc.
- We therefore need to include strategies in our job search toolbox to locate some of these "hidden green jobs."

1. Go Direct

- Some organizations may not utilize job boards, but post job opportunities on their website.
- To access these opportunities job seekers should **identify organizations they would be interested in working for** and review the Jobs or Careers section of their website for potential jobs.

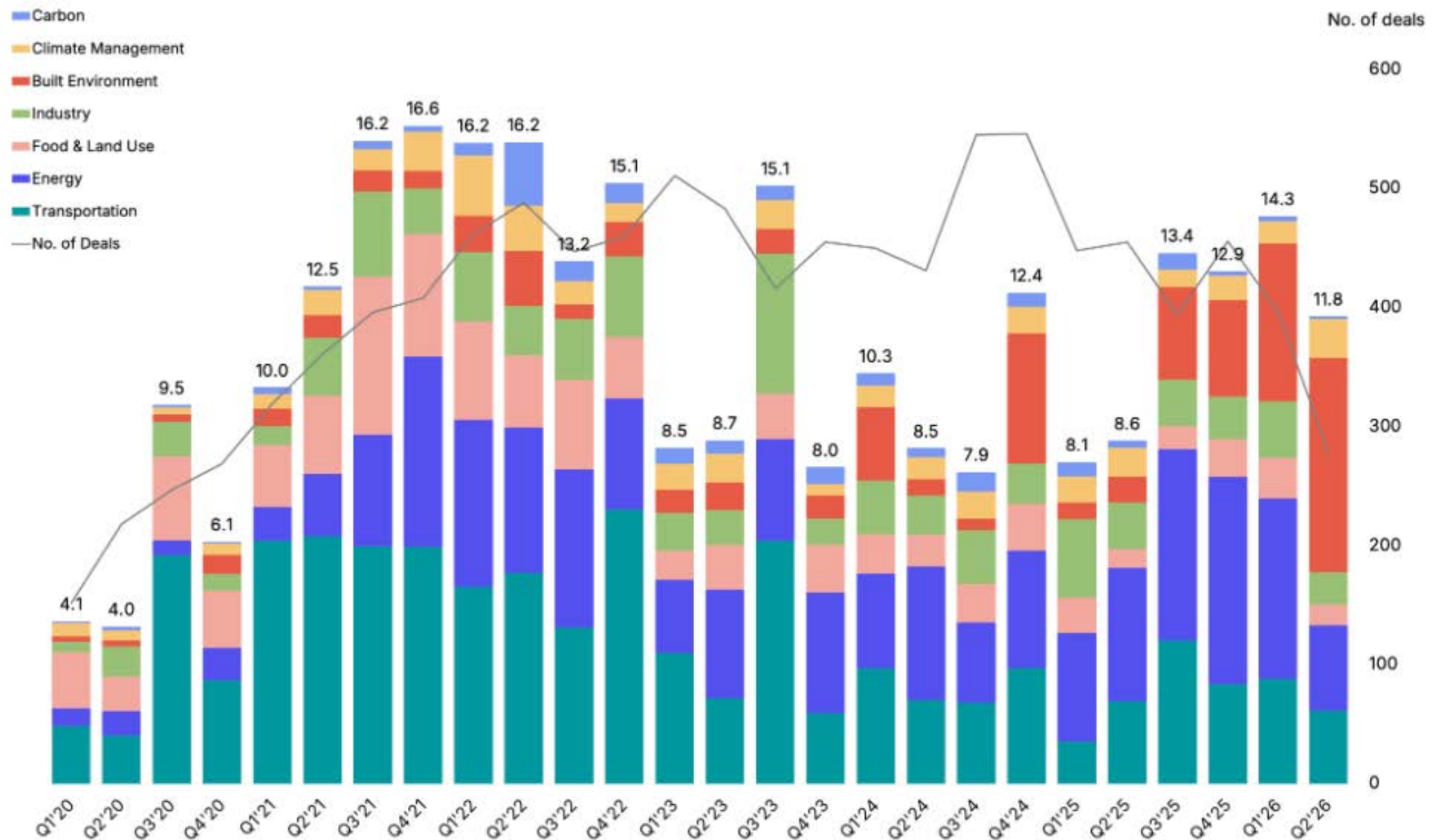

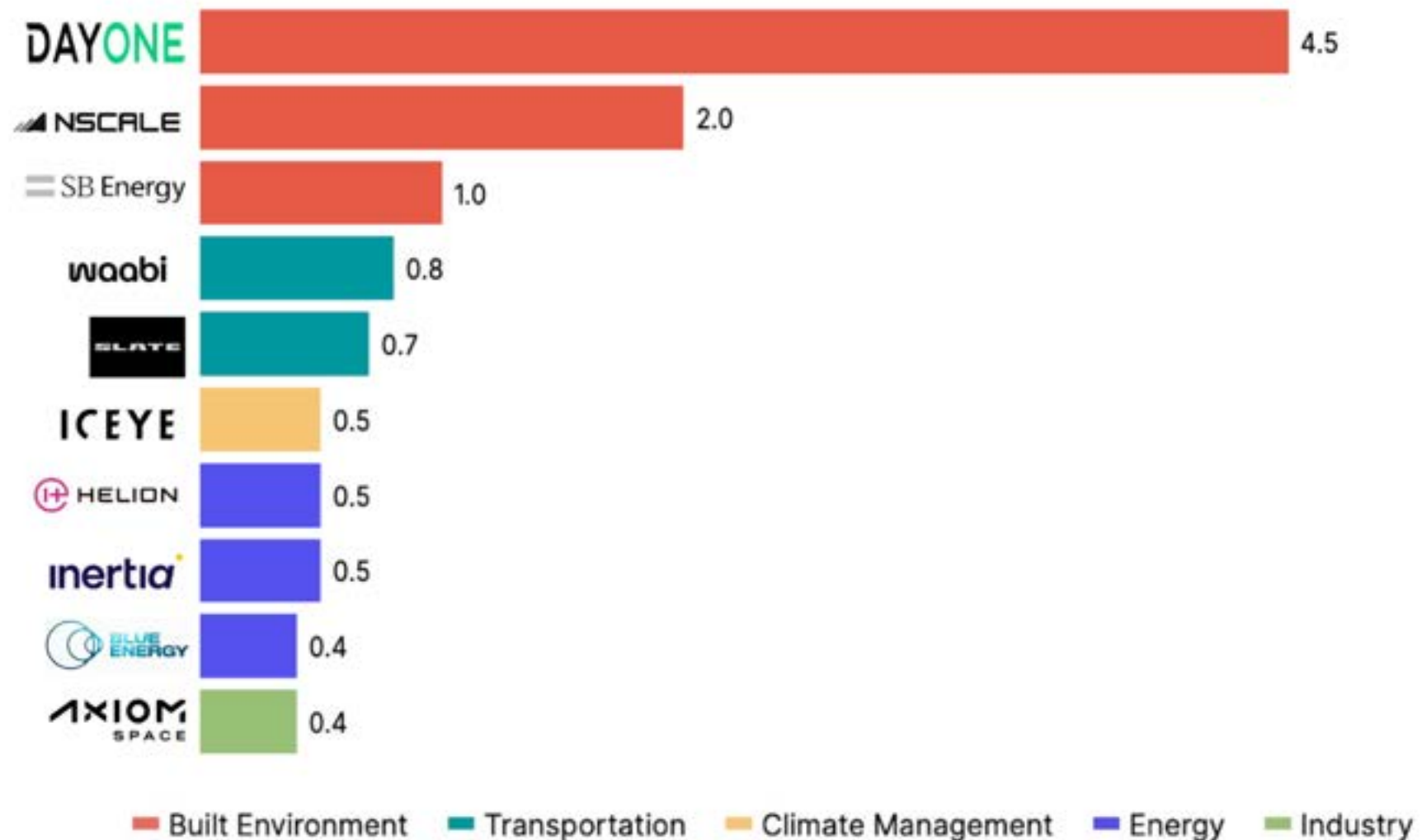

April 29, 2026

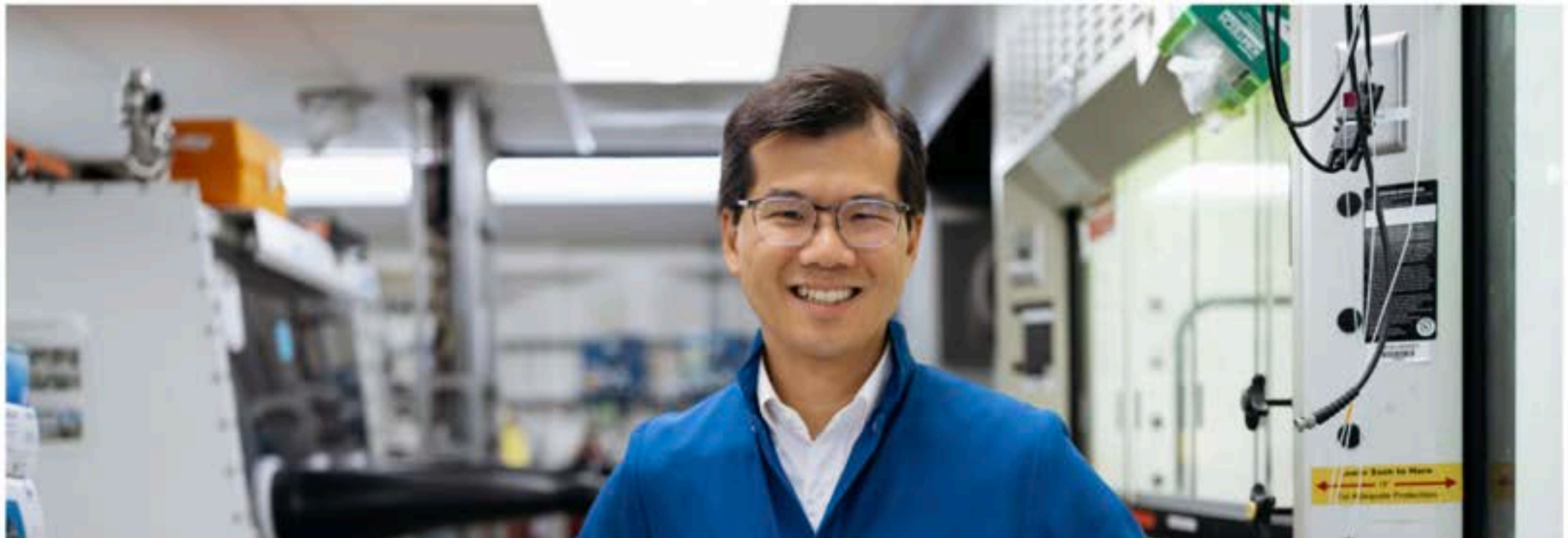
